Mr. Richard Watts admitted to Parkview Nursing & Rehabilitation after a one month stay at Select Specialty Hospital. He presented with significant deficits in neuromuscular and laryngeal/pharyngeal function affecting his ability to engage in daily living and social activities. Richard was dependent in all areas of activities of daily living. He was non-ambulatory and was unable to tolerate a mechanical soft diet with nectar thick liquids.

After 64 days of extensive occupational, physical, and speech therapy, Mr. Watts became independent for basic activities of daily living. He was able to tolerate a regular diet with thin liquids, ambulate independently with a rolling walker, and ascend and descend 13+ stairs.
